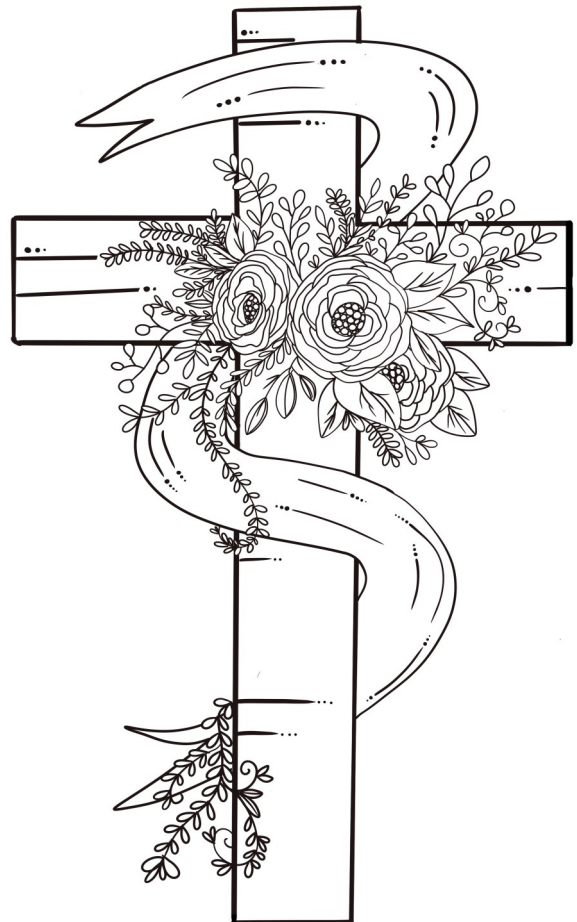

Youth Group Mission Statement

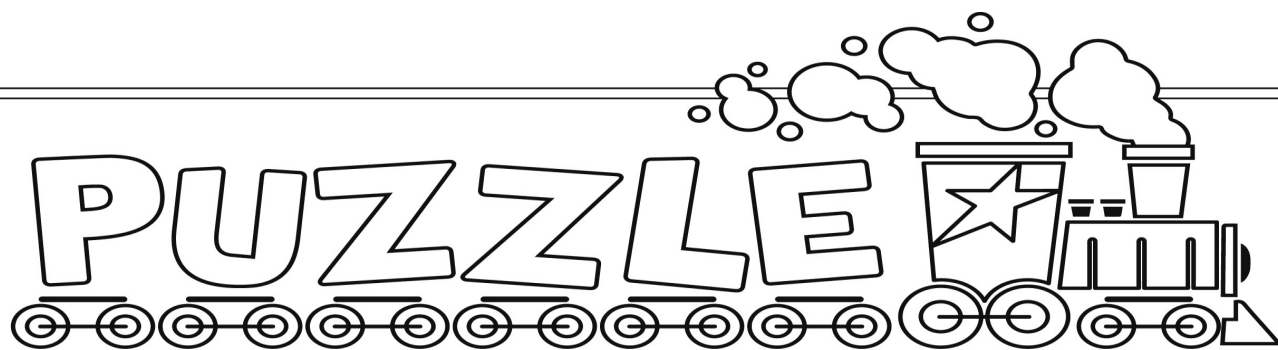

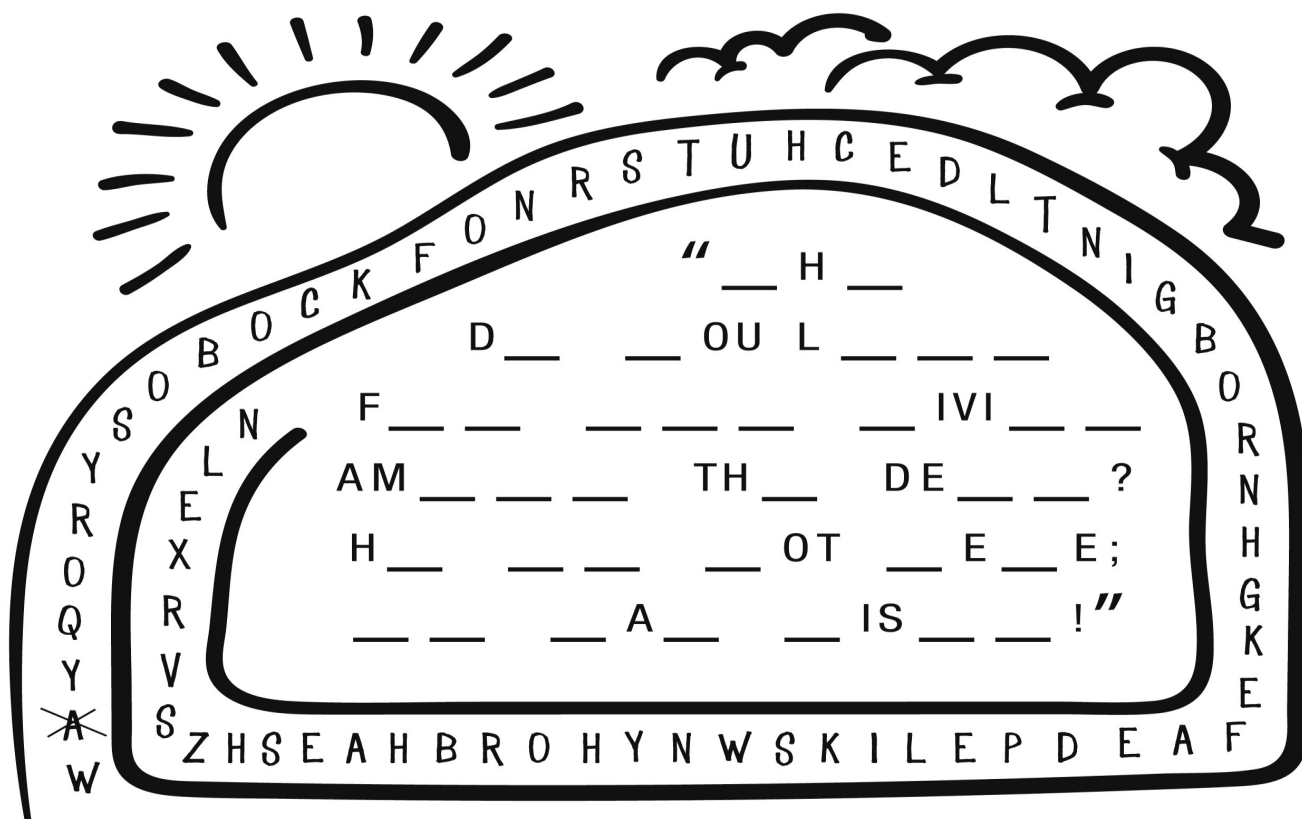




EASTER MORNING *message*
