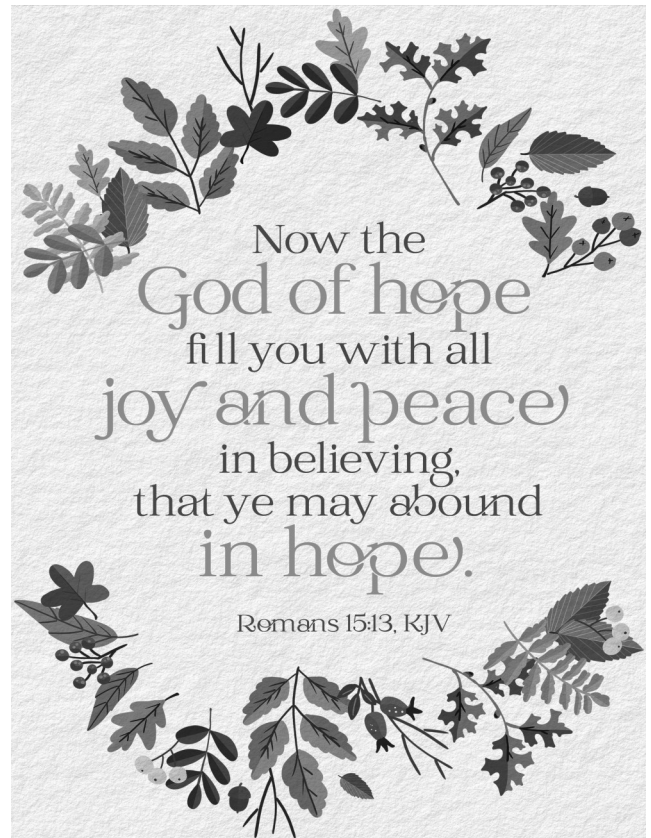
Thursday evening, October 26th at 7 pm!

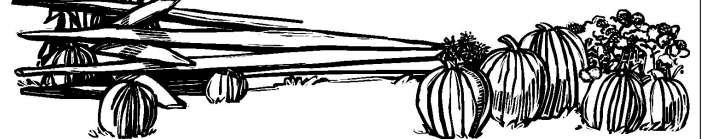

This is for their safety and for leaders to have peace of mind knowing that they are safe!

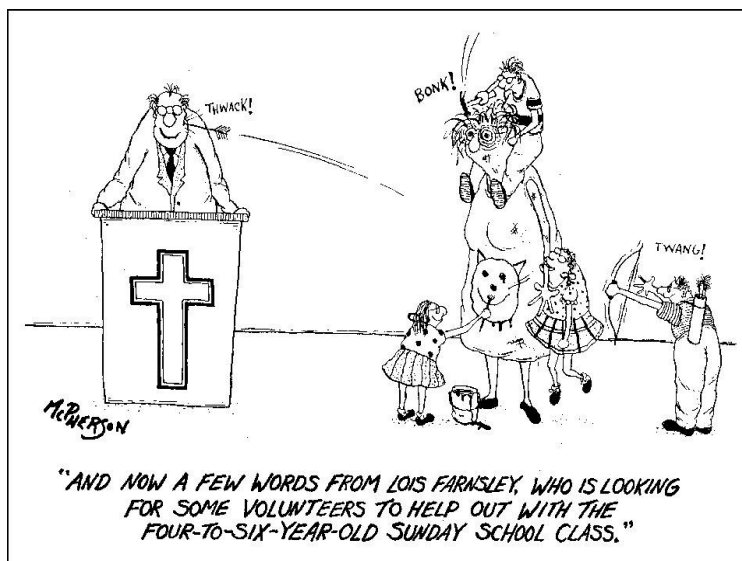
Youth Group Mission Statement

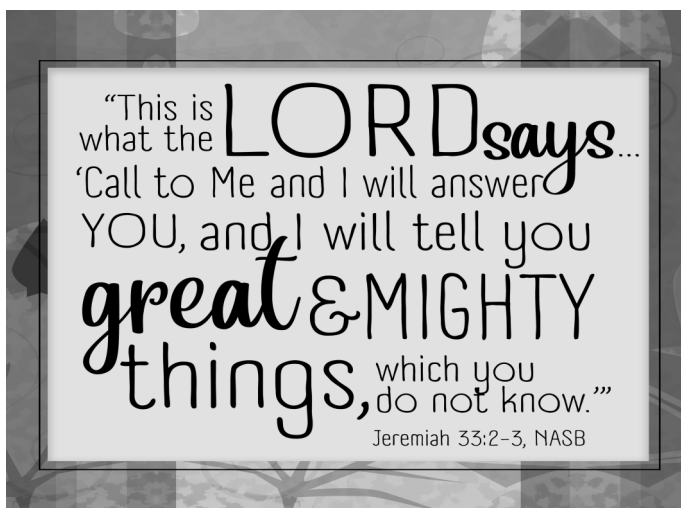
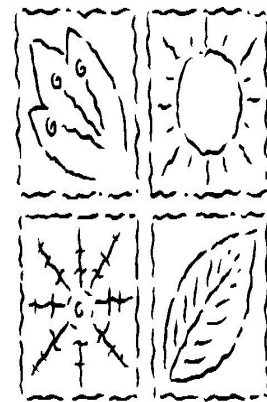
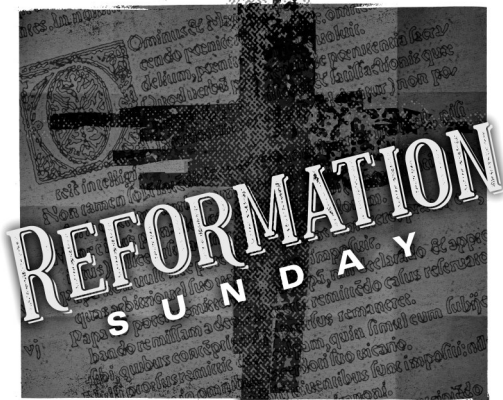
