

**From the Trustees... Did you know in 2024...  
The following projects were completed!**



**Church**

1. Drywalled front of stage and painted
2. Installed 4 extra receptacles on front of the stage
3. Replaced the old emergency lighting batteries
4. Paved and lined parking lot
5. Built a GaGa Ball Pit
6. Made steps for the front of the stage
7. Lighting for front of drive up ramp to church
8. Receptacles and lighting at the entrance to the social hall
9. Janitor cabinets in restroom for supplies
10. Updated fire alarm system
11. Framed leaded window to be hung in church
12. Installed door on hallway storage closet
13. Pressured washed all external steps and walkways at church
14. Library: Painted room, shampooed carpet, installed curtains, installed TV & DVD player, installed printer, Moved the library to new location
15. Records room: Painted room, shampooed carpet, installed curtain, moved filing cabinets
16. New locks installed, made central key location
17. Painted external man door on old church, painted external basement doors to the old church basement, painted external man door at youth room

**Parsonage**

1. Insulated, drywalled, and painted garage
2. Had windows finished framing and base board done in garage
3. Installed new external light bulbs
4. Cleaned out the basement
5. Installed new bulbs in basement
6. Removed old patio concrete
7. Swaled the back of parsonage
8. Seeded new grass seed
9. Installed new patio
10. Painted the walls
11. Replaced door stops
12. Placed new flooring in kitchen, living room, downstairs bedroom and hallway
13. Removed old appliances and replaced with new stove, refrigerator, and dishwasher
14. Changed door bell and switches
15. Replaced 5 windows in the house
16. Replaced patio door and boards under the door
17. Repaired front door
18. Pressure washed sidewalk
19. Shocked well and tested
20. Serviced AC compressor
21. Installed smoke all new detectors
